## TRAP FREE NEW MEXICO PETITION TO BAN TRAPS AND POISONS ON PUBLIC LANDS



We, the undersigned, seek to prohibit the use of poisons and traps on New Mexico's public lands. Traps (including steel-jaw, leg-hold traps, wire snares, and other body-gripping devices) and poisons do not reliably differentiate between species. Traps and poisons cause death and harm to many animals, including endangered wolves, bears, bobcats, foxes, otters and even people's pets. Using traps and poisons is inconsistent with the "fair chase" principles of ethical hunting, and their usage depletes wildlife communities.
